**A**lthough we are already in the second month of the new year I take this opportunity to wish those of you that I haven't already spoken to, a very happy 2015. Welcome to another year of speech and drama festivals.

By now you should have received your 2015 Membership Forms which were emailed and posted last month. If you have not yet received anything please contact me. It is important to receive the Membership Form so I can update any new details. Please return the form even if details have not changed.

The 2015 annual membership fee is R350 per school or studio, individual entry fees are R20 per item for all grades, and group entry fees are R70 per item for all grades. As in previous years, if a pupil enters three or more different, individual items he/she may have one free individual item. The full fee schedule is included in the Booking Form that was sent to you. Please note the closing dates for your 2015 entries so that you too can plan ahead.

Thank you for your early bookings. It makes planning a lot easier, especially for those busy weeks in May and August. Nine schools are having festivals this term and schools that have booked festivals in the second term will receive their entry forms shortly. If you prefer to receive your entry forms by email please indicate this when you book your dates.

We are still using the 2014 - 2016 Syllabus. If you did not receive it last year, or if you wish to order additional copies in English, Afrikaans or isiZulu, you may do so on your Membership Form or directly from the office.

We have a number of 2011 - 2013 Syllabus books in English and Afrikaans that are available, free, to any school that would like to have extra copies. Please arrange to collect them from the office.

## NEW ARTS PRECINCT IN UMBILO!

Contrary to popular belief, the Arts in Durban are alive and well! A wonderful new venue has recently opened at 106 Williams Road in lower Umbilo. This beautiful venue is a little gem located in an industrial area that promises to become Durban's coolest Arts venue.

The Rickshaw Collective, based at Precinct 106, is primarily a dance venue but also offers drama classes and has rehearsal space for hire. The venue is on the third floor of a factory warehouse, which was the original Rickshaw depot and repair compound. It has toilet and shower facilities and secure parking.

Some of the Ballet classes on offer are Ballet Bridge (basic ballet techniques), Neo-classical Ballet (a class that draws on the technical mastery of Classical Ballet and the expressive freedom of Contemporary Dance. Ballet experience needed) and Ballet Extension (open classes for technically accomplished ballet dancers who are in search of extension work that goes beyond set syllabi.) Other styles are Movement, Musical Theatre, Mime, African Contemporary, Afro-fusion, Contemporary, Booty-Shake, Bollywood and Hip Hop. There are a number of practitioners teaching at this amazing venue, however there are still available slots for teachers who would like to get involved. Come along and be inspired by Shelby Strange, Thobi Maphanga, Julia Wilson, Vusi Makhanya, Daisy Spencer, Bronwyn Botha, Krazy Kayzo, Sashin Kandhai and Winsome Fuller. There are also Body Conditioning classes that aim to keep the body flexible, strengthen the core and raise fitness levels. Yoga classes will be available in the near future.
